Meeting Minutes

The March 2020 Tuckesse Woodturners Club Meeting was called to order by President Steve Sabinash at 7:00 pm on Monday March 2nd at the FOP Lodge 2576 North Ford Street in Clarksville TN.

Old Business:

Jon Holloway reported on the possible sale of the FOP Lodge Building. The building including 4 or 5 acres of land is listed for sale at \$190,000.00. We would likely receive 30 to 45 days' notice to vacate once it sells. We need to identify our equipment stored there to be sure there is no confusion regarding what goes with the building and what is ours. A discussion was held regarding a possible new meeting place. It is not likely we can afford the site on Fort Campbell that had been mentioned last month. There is still interest in working out an arrangement with the APSU Art Department to use space there. Mike Patrick has a place where we could store our equipment if we need to. The Bikers Who Care space in New Providence was also mentioned. The consensus is you must be a member or family member to use that facility. Bob Forsythe will check with a friend to see what the possibilities are.

President Steve advised our application to participate in the 2020 Clarksville Farmers Market is pending. We should know soon if we are approved. The market will start in May this year and end in September.

The Vintage Fair will be held April 25th little interest was expressed by members wanting to participate so we will not participate this year.

Treasurer Bob Forsythe reported that we have \$1,444.87 in our account and an additional \$120.00 in cash to be deposited. Our annual insurance premium to AAW of \$200.00 has not yet been paid nor has the cost of the membership directories been paid.

Charles Wall passed out the 2020 Membership Directories. The cost was slightly higher than last year. There were more pages printed and a few more copies printed than was the case last year.

Take N. 2nd Street north onto Hwy 41A (Providence Blvd), turn right on Market St, turn right on Chapel St, turn left on North Ford St. About one-half mile road turns hard right. Continue about one-half mile to the last building on the Left. (F.O.P. Lodge)

FROM THE NORTH

From Hwy 41A (Providence Blvd) turn left on Chapel St About ¼ mi. turn left on North Ford St. About ½ mi. rd turns hard right, continue about ½ mile to the last building on the Left. (F.O.P. Lodge)
